Municipal Housing (Shiei Juutaku)

For those interested in low-rent municipal housing (*shiei juutaku*) the registration time is coming soon. This process will take a minimum of 3 trips to the City Hall (One for picking up the application/ explanation, for turning in the application, and then for the choosing/lottery), assuming you have all your paperwork in order. You must have a permanent residency status and a Japanese co-signor/ guarantor. You also need to have a family and/or dependents to qualify, as well as earnings/salary prerequisite of 114,000 yen per month or less.

The rooms available are 2K and 3DK, there are no 2DK apartments available this year.

The lottery will be held Friday, July 15th from 2 PM at the City Hall 4th floor, Daikaigi-shitsu EAST. Those who do not place in the lottery may be put on a waiting list for up to 6 months beginning August 1st.
