#### Child Rearing Allowance (jidō fuyō teate seido)

### Single Parent Household Assistance

Those who wish to receive this assistance must apply by May 25<sup>th</sup> at the Child Care Support Division (*Kosodate shien-ka*). If you qualify, this will provide the single parent with an additional 6,000 yen per child once a year.

# SPECIAL NOTICE Regarding Kakamigahara International Association (KIA) Language Study Courses

Due to the coronavirus, all KIA-operated language courses for 2020 (Japanese, English, Korean, and Chinese) will be suspended until the coming fall (September/October). This is subject to further change, depending on how the situation develops.

#### Quick Announcement Regarding Coronavirus Emergency Loans (Tokurei Kashitsuke)

Due to the pressures caused by the current coronavirus threat, many people are experiencing financial strain. Monies have been allocated to help alleviate these pressures for the public. Therefore, the government is making allowances through the Welfare Fund Loan System lending program to temporarily lend money to households whose income has been decreased.

In general, this is for up to 100,000 yen, though there are special cases for consideration where this amount can be higher (to a maximum of 200,000 yen):

A. A family member is infected with the novel coronavirus.

B. A family member requires nursing care.

C. A household has more than 4 family members.

D. When a working household member needs to take care of the following:

• A child attending elementary school that is temporarily closed to prevent the spread of novel coronavirus infection.

• If your child attends an elementary school where a child has shown symptoms of illness or may be infected with the novel coronavirus.

E. When income has decreased and is insufficient to cover living expenses and the income is through self-employment.

F. When there is a recognizable need for funds in addition to the conditions above.

Loans must be paid back within 2 years (up to 24 payments), with a deferment period of up to one year. There is no interest on this loan, and no need for a guarantor. Non-Japanese residents may also apply, and are subject to the same consideration as Japanese nationals.

Note that application does not guarantee a loan will be given. Please check the city homepage for more details. Please inquire to the Kakamigahara Municipal Social Welfare Council at TEL 058-383-7610, or the Gifu Prefectural Social Welfare Council at TEL 058-273-1111 (internal line 2513 or 2514).
